3rd Module: O.N.R THERAPEUTICS. (II)

This course has special interest for both, the General Practitioner and the Orthodontist. Through a thorough prosthesis analysis a better understanding and knowledge about the Masticatory System Physiology is reached.

Información general

1 - Location:

Courses take place at Dentoclinic, Barcelona. Besides the area for patient treatment and reception, this facility includes a conference room and a wide laboratory. Everything has been set with teaching purposes, both theoretical and practice hands-on.

2 - Dates
